TO MAKE A LODGE BANNER

Requested Measurements:

2 feet wide

3 feet long

1. Includes fringe and decorations
2. Dowel should be 2 feet plus ends, no decorations on ends.
3. Casing on top to put dowel through.
4. String across, 6" - middle of banner to top of pole.

Pole: If we all use a PVC 1- ½ inch pole, white, our District 2 convention will make the bases so they can be used from convention to convention. Pole should be 7 feet long.

Banner includes:

Name and Number of your lodge

City and State

Picture or logo from your area

Suggested type of fabric: felt, burlap, or nylon type of fabric.
